McGraw Hill App: Reading and Grammar

1) Log into Clever using badge or username & password

2) Open McGraw hill App (inside Clever)

3) Choose Wonders Grade 2 book...blue with Marlin fish

4) On the opening page, click the green bubble on the left side of the Marlin. All resources and assignments are preloaded on the TO DO list. Each week the To Do list will reload.

5) Once open, click on individual assignment titles, one at a time, to complete assignments. Scroll down to see all assignment titles.

6) When the assignment opens, double click on the resource thumbnail picture that appears in the upper right hand corner of the page. (Do not hit the wheel to open the resource.)

7) Click SUBMIT after completing all assignments or activities.

8) For assignments that require written answers - click the "T" symbol on the very bottom, left of the page to type

directly onto the page. Hit the Save symbol (floppy disk) Remember to hit SUBMIT when it is complete.

9) Tests are accessed by going to the blue tab on top of the TO DO list and selecting MY TESTS. Click the green button - TAKE NOW. Click the "T" symbol to type directly on the test. Remember to submit.

Piggy Bank Directions

Make a bank project using any household item that you may have. These items may include a milk or juice carton, butter tub, shoe box, diaper wipe tub, dishwashing detergent bottle, plastic soda bottle, etc. Your bank does not have to have a pig shape. Be creative. **Nothing needs to be purchased for this project.** Use the following steps to complete your project.

1. Choose something to make your bank.
2. Decorate your bank with whatever you would like. It may include markers, crayons, construction paper, paint, stickers, newspaper, colored tape, etc. (Remember, your bank should be made by the child.)
3. Have a grown up cut a slot for your money.
4. Take a picture of you with your bank and have a parent send it to your teacher's email address or on the Remind app.
